Application process

STEP 1: **Tell us about your organisation** by emailing us at DaringCircles@womens-forum.com and providing the information below:

Your name and contact information, the name of your business, your location and the geography that you serve.

Please answer the following either by sending us a word document or presentation:

- What access to health challenge is your organisation tackling?
 - o Lack of health care providers informed by sex-disaggregated research
 - o Barriers to accessing mental health care
 - o Limited awareness or access to information
 - Limited physical access to care
 - o Lack of confidential or reliable health records or identification
 - Lack of means to pay or time-poverty
- Please elaborate on how your organisation is tackling the above challenge(s)? (300 words limit)
- What is your strategic plan for the next 2 years? How would support from the Daring Circle fit into that plan? (200 word limit)
- Do you have a last message for us? (200 words limit)

STEP 2: If you are one of our 10 semi-finalists, convince our jury members how your work is having the most scalable impact on increasing women's access to health.

The second and final step involves your in-person participation at our March event where you will have the opportunity to pitch your organisation to our jury members. If you are selected, prepare a pitch no longer than 6 minutes around the following ideas:





- How is your organisation addressing health care barriers that disproportionately impact women?
- What do you do differently from other businesses? What sets your solution apart?
- What is your story and purpose, and how would support from our global Daring Circle of partners help you have the impact that you desire?
- What would it mean to you to be a member of a global community of entrepreneurs dedicated to women's access to health?
